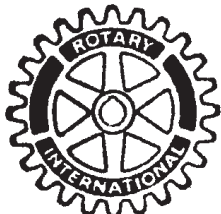

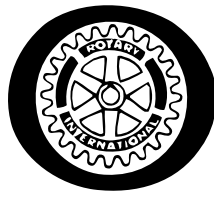

Coach Briles took the position of head coach at the University of Houston in 2003, and for five seasons led them to four bowl appearances and a Conference USA title in 2006.

also served as the president of the Texas High School Coaches Association.
