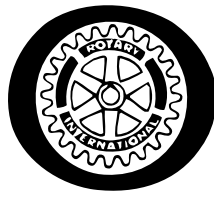

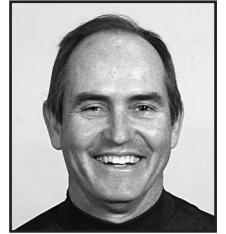

One month from tomorrow, the Baylor Bears kick off the 2011 football season at Floyd Casey Stadium against old Southwest Conference rival TCU. Coach Art Briles begins his fourth season as Baylor's head coach. He is a native Texan who has played and coached his entire career in Texas. He built the program at Stephenville into a perennial powerhouse. At the University of Houston, he rebuilt its program and was selected as Baylor's coach to do the same. After Baylor's first winning season since the mid-1990's, the Bears are looking forward to another successful year. He and wife, Jan, have two daughters, a son, a daughter-in-law, and one grandson.

Congressman Bill Flores was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in November 2010 and currently represents the 17th Congressional District of Texas. Congressman Flores serves as a Member on the Budget, Natural Resources and Veterans' Affairs Committees.

Before retiring to pursue public service, Congressman Flores served as CFO for a number of successful energy companies and ultimately became the CEO and president of Phoenix Exploration Company. Congressman Flores earned a BBA in Accounting from Texas A&M University and an MBA from Houston Baptist University. He and his wife Gina have provided scholarships, faculty fellowships, and infrastructure investments to support higher education at Texas A&M University and Houston Baptist University. They are also major benefactors of K-12 education, including support for Yellowstone Academy, which

provides elementary education to children in one of Houston's poorest inner city areas.

In 2010, Texas A&M University honored him as a Distinguished Alumnus, its highest award for Former Students.

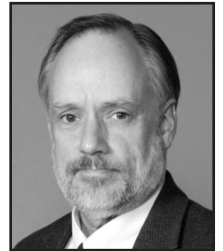

Dr. Matthew S. Stanford is professor of psychology, neuroscience, and biomedical studies at Baylor University. He serves as the graduate director for the Psychology Doctoral Program. He received his Ph.D. in Neuroscience from Baylor in 1992. After graduating from Baylor he completed a post-doctoral fellowship in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the University of Texas Medical Branch.

He is also the director of the Mental Health Grace Alliance, a faith-based, non-profit organization created to promote understanding in the church and provide assistance and support to individuals living with mental illness and their families. His writings in psychology and neuroscience are inspired by the many questions he has received from people of faith and the real life struggles he has observed as friends and acquaintances have attempted to work through the difficult problems associated with mental illness.

Prior to joining TSTC in June 2010, Jim was the President/CEO of Northeast Baptist School in West Monroe, Louisiana. He also served as the Director of Business Development for Dutch Valley Supply Company.

Jim retired as a Colonel from the US Air Force in 2003. During his 30 years in the service, he was a flight instructor, evaluator, and bomber pilot. He flew combat missions during Southern Watch, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom and has more than 4,000 hours of military flying time. 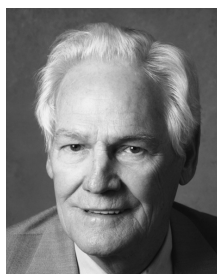

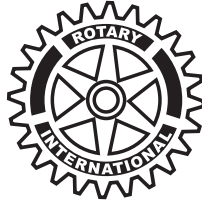
