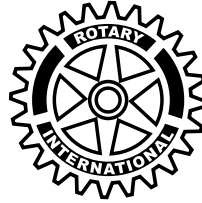

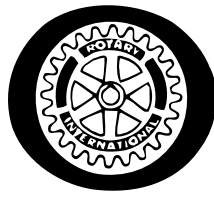

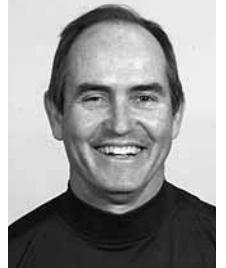

2010 will be Baylor University head football coach Art Briles' third season at Baylor. Having made improvements over the first two years, and with a 2010 signing class ranked 39th nationally by Rivals.com (including a defensive backfield ranked 5th nationally) and superstar quarterback Robert Griffin III healthy, hopes are high in Bear Country for 2010. Coach Briles is a native of Rule, Texas, and played football at the University of Houston. Coach Briles has spent his entire coaching career in Texas, including several positions at Texas high schools and running backs coach at Texas Tech. Prior to coming to Baylor, he resurrected the University of Houston program. He and his wife, Jan, have three children, Jancy, Kendall and Staley.

Sergeant Wallace holds a Master Peace Officer certification, is a S.W.A.T. supervisor for his department and is a certified instructor who conducts a variety of training classes for law enforcement officers.

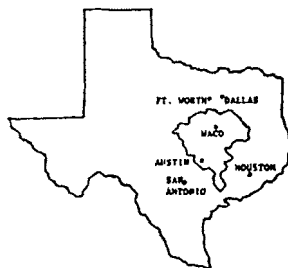
