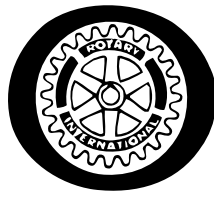

John W. McAnally

John W. McAnally, a local CPA, holds a BBA degree with a major in accounting, and is the majority stockholder of the Certified Public Accounting firm of John W. McAnally, P.C., in Waco.

Since 1968, John has been an avid amateur astronomer. Recently, John has written and published six scientific papers about the planet Jupiter. His papers have included such titles as "Jupiter and the South Temperate Dark Spot of 1998: A Preliminary Report," and a magazine article about observing Jupiter that appeared in the October 2000 issue of *Sky and Telescope* magazine.

Since then, John has often been quoted in this magazine concerning current events on Jupiter, and has provided assistance to professional astronomers in the United States and Europe regarding their own Jupiter research. At the request of Springer Publishing, he has written a Jupiter Observing Guide that will be published as part of the Patrick Moore Series of Practical Astronomy Books.

John also served in the United States Army as a field artillery officer both on active duty and in the Reserves from 1976 to 1996. He is a member of the Astronomical League, the International Occultation Timing Association and the Astronomical Society of the Pacific, and is an immediate past president of the Central Texas Astronomical Society, serving for five years during the construction of the Central Texas observatory.

After his final collegiate season, he played in four all-star games before being drafted by the Philadelphia Eagles. Recognized by the Patriots as an outstanding line-play teacher, in 1988 Coach Morriss began his coaching career with them as an offensive line assistant coach.

Before being named Baylor's head football coach, he spent four seasons as assistant head coach/offensive line coach and two seasons as head coach at the University of Kentucky.
