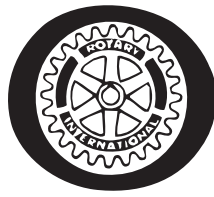

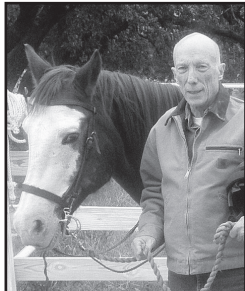

Larry Barnett will present information about REACH and the benefits of horses and horseback riding for children and adults with special needs. People with disabilities, from ADD and autism to cerebral palsy and Downs syndrome, can benefit from time with and on a horse.

REACH has three programs:

Therapeutic Riding - These lessons are taught by PATH certified instructors (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship) with the main goal being to achieve independence through learning horsemanship and riding skills within the rider's abilities.

Hippotherapy - These sessions are provided by licensed therapists (occupational, physical, and speech language pathologists). The horse and its movement is used as a tool to achieve specific goals and objectives.

Horses for Heroes - A new program to provide the benefits of horses and riding to our wounded or disabled veterans.

They will present some standard jazz and popular music numbers for your listening pleasure. Be sure to bring your spouse or significant other for this entertaining program.

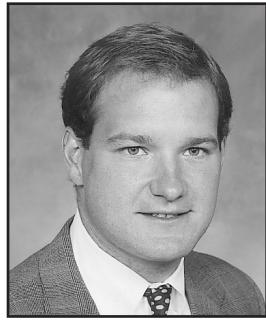
