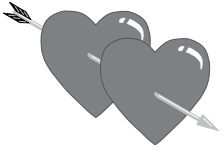
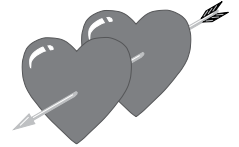

He served for six years as Dean and Professor of Law at Pepperdine University, teaching constitutional issues and civil procedure. 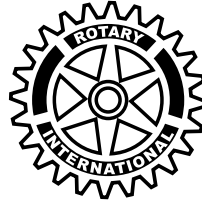
