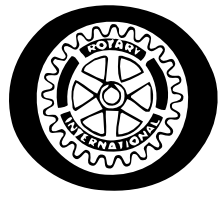

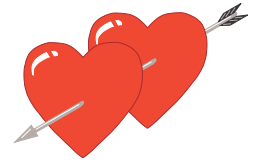

In the past 12 years, Steve Smith holds the best winning percentage of any coach in Baylor's history. He has led Baylor to eight NCAA Regional appearances, three NCAA Super Regionals and one College World Series.

Steve has coached 12 All-American selections and seven USA National Team members while at Baylor.

A former standout pitcher at Baylor in 1982-83, Steve led the conference with a 1.72 ERA as a junior and was drafted by the San Francisco Giants and he played for four years before entering the coaching ranks.

He has tutored seven pitchers in the last 12 years who were then selected in the first round of the Major League Baseball draft and he has coached at least one all-conference pitcher in each of his 12 years at Baylor.
