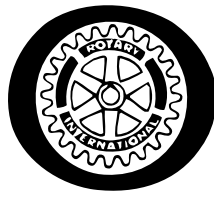

Tom Clowe has served as the senior executive of many major corporations and organizations over a period of fifty years in the United States and Canada. He is widely known and respected for his motivational skills and a positive, hands-on management style that has transformed several corporate cultures, advanced government agencies and dramatically increased productivity and profitability in those organizations. Tom has successfully steered companies through sweeping transportation and utility deregulation and has also served as a top Texas regulator.

In 1998, Tom retired as Senior Vice-President, Strategic Planning for the Southern Union Company and began a significant career in the public sector, serving on the Texas Racing Commission, Texas Safety Commission, Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum Advisory Board, and Chairman of the Texas Lottery Commission. In 2003, Tom performed an organization audit of the State Bar of Texas with the goal of improving the services of the Texas Bar. Currently, Tom is a developer of rural property in Texas.

Tom will speak on his time with the Department of Safety, which included the Texas Rangers, Texas Highway Patrol, Criminal Investigation Division as well as Crime Labs, Aircraft, Driver Licenses, and Concealed Handgun Licenses, and on the Role of Public Service.

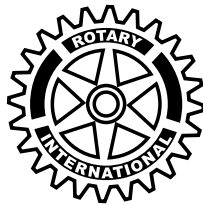
